Mobility of Engineering Professionals in Asean Countries

(A) About Singapore Institute of Engineering Technologists (SIET)

SIET was founded in **1980** as a national professional body to cater for the interests of Polytechnic and VITB (now ITE) engineering and Technology graduates in Singapore.

SIET individual membership is structured into the following grades : Honorary Fellows (**Hon. FSIET**), Fellows (**FSIET**), Members (**MSIET**), Associate Members (**AMSIET**) and Associates (**Assoc.SIET**).

SIET revised Professional Examinations are held in three main Engineering Disciplines : **Civil, Electrical and Mechanical** at three broad levels/standard : **Level 1** (Associate Membership → **AMSIET**), **Level 2** (Membership → **MSIET**) and **Level 3** (Fellowship → **FSIET**).

Suitably qualified Engineering graduates can apply to become **MSIET** [Entrance Fee : S\$60 ; Annual Subscription : S\$80; Total : **S\$140.00***] and also become **MTAM** [Entrance Fee : RM30.00; Annual Subscription : RM50.00] and **AAET** [RM50.00] under the **Joint SIET-TAM-AER Scheme**. [***SIET Council has agreed to 'absorb' fees payable to TAM & AER for SIET members joining the TAM as members and AER as AAET/AAT.**]

(B) About the Technological Association Malaysia (TAM)

The **Technical Association Malaysia (TAM)** was formed in **1946** to represent all technical professions, craft and trades as well as all grades of personnel from technicians up to the highest professions. The name was changed to **Technological Association of Malaysia (TAM)** in **1972** to reflect the multi-professional memberships.

TAM individual membership is structured into the following grades : Fellows (**FTAM**), Members (**MTAM**), Graduate Members, Student Members and Associates.

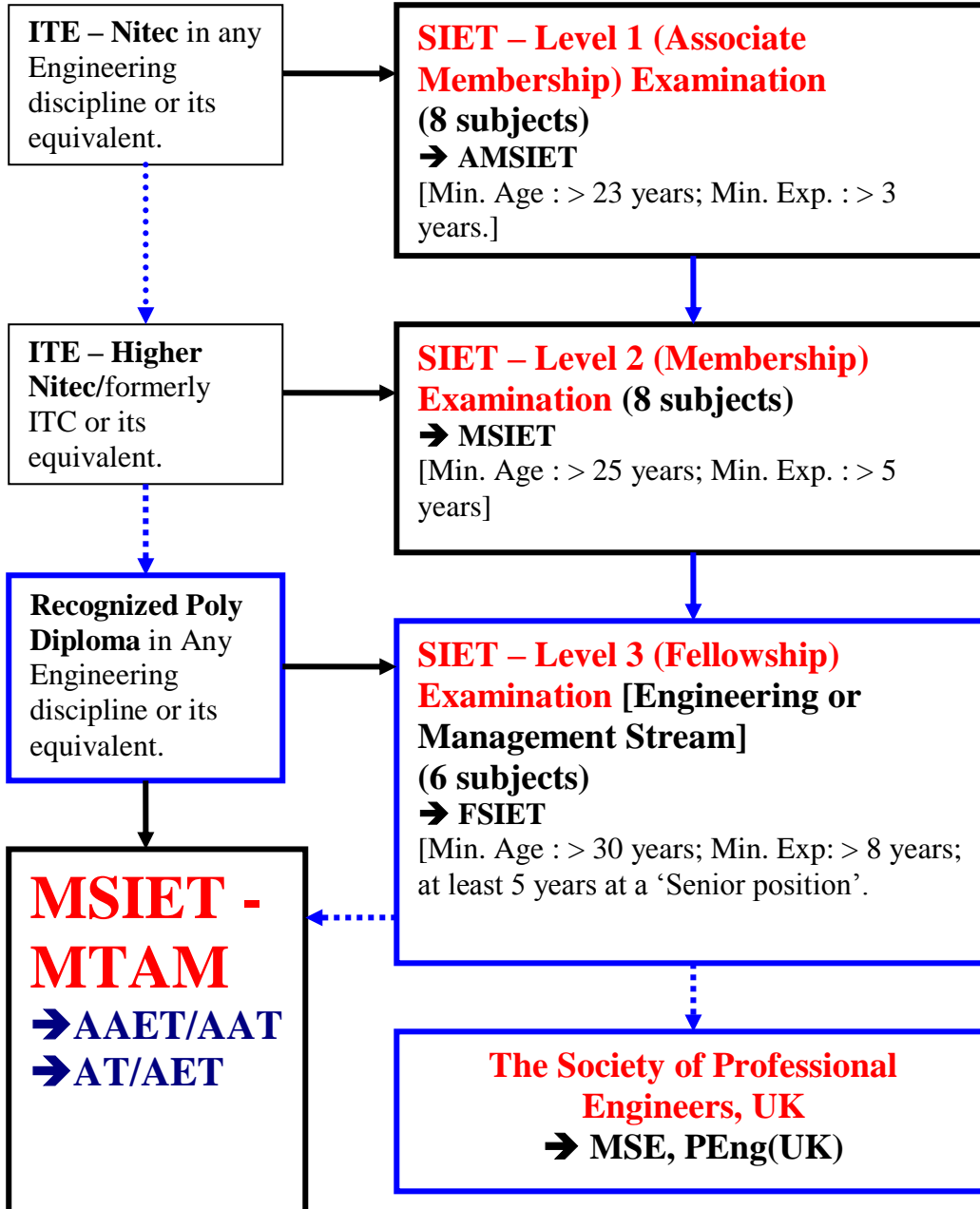
1999 : Finalised the Formation of ASEAN Engineers Register (AER).
